Shooting instructions and target labels should be with you by the end of October at the latest. If you have not received them by then please let me know and we shall send out a repeat order.

We would also point out all that in the prone leagues shooting from a bench with both elbows touching the bench is acceptable (but no part of the rifle) and that orthoptic apertures may well assist you in using service sights. – this is, put simply, a small disk with a hole of about 1mm in it, fitted behind, or even in front of, your glasses or shooting prescription lens. This can be easily made at home, or an adjustable pistol type iris may also be used.

We would also urge you to consider most carefully your ability to complete the year's targets as not finishing can offer an advantage or disadvantage to others in your division

We look forward to welcoming you to this year's competition
