Details of the new

•22 Bolt-action Rifles

THE three new B.S.A. "Sportsman" Rifles will, without doubt, prove extremely popular amongst those who require a light, easily handled, yet hard-hitting .22 rifle for general sporting purposes. Of extremely simple yet efficient design, these newcomers are introduced with the fullest confidence. A smooth, fast-operating bolt-assembly, common to the "Sportsman" range, gives efficient extraction and snappy ejection, while the new flat type firing pin ensures consistent performance and long life. The bolt locking handle can be removed by a simple turn, leaving the firing pin free to slide out. The rifle has a short, crisp trigger pull and all working parts are readily dismantled for cleaning when necessary. All three rifles incorporate a safety device within the bolt, operated by pulling back and partly turning the striker body knob. In keeping with the advanced engineering refinements of B.S.A. weapons, the "Sportsman" has a barrel that is carefully bored and rifled and is capable of exceptionally fine accuracy. All models are fitted with an adjustable rearsight and bead foresight, together with a smart one-piece stock with comfortable pistol grip. The overall length is $42\frac{3}{4}$ ins.

"Sportsman"

A single shot .22 Long Rifle bolt-action rifle, of highest quality workmanship and dependable action. The simple bolt action is smooth and efficient in operation whilst an improved cartridge support ensures a clean straight-line feed. The weight is approximately $5\frac{1}{4}$ lbs.

"Sportsman-Rive'

Similar in general design to the "Sportsman," this model has in addition a detachable box magazine holding five Long Rifle cartridges. The magazine is easily withdrawn by pressing the thumb catch. The weight is approximately $5\frac{1}{4}$ lbs.

"Sportsman-Ten"

G3-5-21-5-5.

Again similar to the "Sportsman," this model has in addition a tubular magazine with a capacity of ten Long Rifle cartridges. The feed mechanism is completely new and has been designed to ensure trouble-free operation. The weight is approximately 5¹/₃ lbs.
