



*Pneumatic.*—An air-gun having the same size, shape, balance, and sighting as a service rifle is made by the attachment to the air-compression chamber *b* of an air-gun of a tubular body or extension *a* mounted on the stock *g*. The trigger *d* is connected to the sear *i* by a rod *k*. In a modification, the rod *l* of the spring plunger is

made of a length sufficient to extend into the body *a*, and the trigger is directly connected with the sear,

A fixed breech-block with handle *a²* and a dummy magazine *e* may be provided. The service sights are employed.
